### **Project Details:**

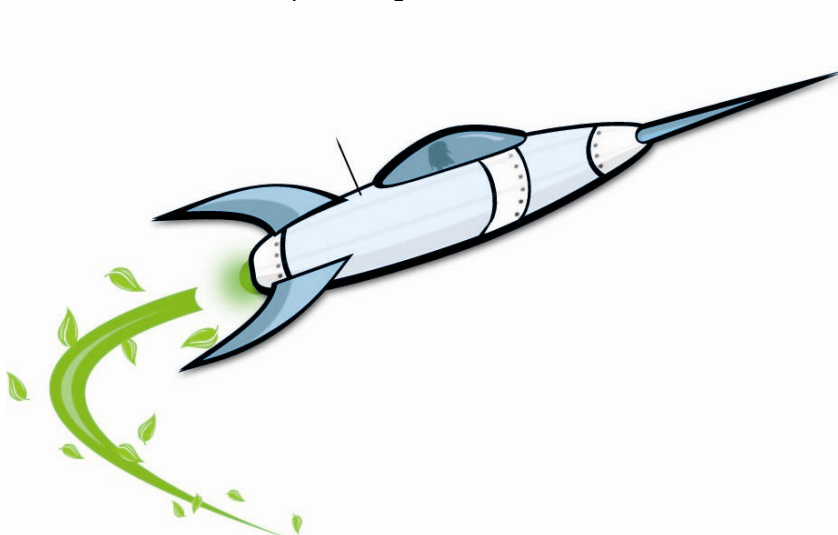
Through our greening initiatives with our title sponsor, Esurance, Monolith wishes to achieve a massive on-site presence for environmental messaging. **Our goal is to create a rocket ship, in large format, using only recycled materials.** The finished product will be prominently displayed during the festival to draw attention to our greening message. More than just a piece of art, ideally the ship would have some type of receptacle that can house recyclables, encouraging our attendees to use this piece as an educational recycling tool. Following the festival, the rocket ship can be used to take on “tour” to various local galleries and Greenprint Denver events. Plus, Monolith will implement a full scale local PR campaign centered around the mission, the rocket ship and the artist.

### **Dimensions:**

Height: Minimum 8 feet tall; Width: Minimum 3 feet around

### **Theme:**

The rocket ship should resemble the artwork based on our website. We have no preference on the orientation of the ship, as long as it is stable.



A diagonal “blast-off position” would be best.

**Materials:**

All recyclable materials must be used. A log of materials must be kept throughout the project to put display with the finished piece. Must be structurally sound with ability to stand on its own or have proper "braces" to secure safety.

**Compensation:**

- **\$1000 inclusive of materials, expenses, and artist compensation**
- Event Tickets to the 2007 MONOLITH Festival
- Artist recognition on-site with finished piece
- Feature on Monolithfestival.com

**Deadlines:**

Submit concepts to Josh Baker by August 24<sup>th</sup>. Sketches are encouraged, they can be as simple or elaborate as you choose. Ideas for materials are encouraged to be included in the proposal.
